

Medi-Cal Rx PAVE Enrollment for ORP Providers

Why is this important?

Pharmacy providers and prescribers who are not yet enrolled as a Medi-Cal provider in the Provider Application and Validation for Enrollment (PAVE) system are encouraged to enroll as an Ordering, Referring, and Prescribing (ORP) with their Type 1 individual National Provider Identifier (NPI) in order to register for the Medi-Cal Rx Secured Provider Portal.

How does this affect stakeholders?

In order to provide services to Medi-Cal beneficiaries, there are three basic requirements for ORP providers:

- 1. The ORP provider must be enrolled in Medi-Cal.
- 2. The ORP provider's enrolled NPI must be for an individual (Type 1 NPI only, not an organizational Type 2 NPI).
- 3. The ORP provider must be eligible to order, refer, and/or prescribe in accordance with law and the health care practitioner's practice act.

Dental providers do **not** register through PAVE – they must register through Denti-Cal and have a valid address on file. Providers that are registered with Medi-Cal through a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) must also register individually with PAVE as an ORP using their Type 1 NPI. PAVE enrollment can take up to 90 days.
